Fall 2020 Stopping the Spread

You do your part...

- ◆ If you are showing any symptoms of illness, STAY HOME! Stay home if you are sick! Students must also stay home if they are in direct contact with a sick family member or a family member under investigation for Covid-19.
- ◆ If you have traveled within the last 14 days to any Covid -19 restricted travel area, STAY HOME!
- If you have been in direct contact with anyone who is lab confirmed positive, STAY HOME for at least (14 days-Covid-19, 4 days-Flu, 3 days-Strep) from the last know date of exposure!
- Report to administration immediately any known exposure to Covid/Flu/Strep/ RSV and any other communicable disease that may impact Sherwood.
- Sanitize/wash your lunch boxes everyday, backpacks, & nap materials every week!
- Check your temperature BEFORE coming to school each day, We will ask!
- Parents, please do not enter the facility without consent. All drop off and pick up will take place on the front porch.

Sherwood may have to close in the event of...

- Known case of Covid-19 within the school. We will be under direct guidance of MCDH for reopening procedures and time line. It is not expected that a closure for this reason will exceed 72 hours
- Inability to properly staff classrooms due to illness or quarantine among teachers. (We currently have 7 substitutes lined up for the Fall).
- Inclement weather

All notices of closure and reason for closure will be sent by email to all currently enrolled families. Please set our email as a preferred or vip email to avoid spam.

And we will do our part!

- ♦ Walk children to class after washing their hands and sanitizing all materials coming into the school. Handwashing will also occur throughout the day.
- Restrict public access to the facility. Tours after hours only.
- ♦ We have implemented a 14 day wait period for all new students starting after August 12th.
- Check temperatures throughout the day for students and staff.
- Strictly enforce the same policies we ask you to follow for all staff.
- ♦ Sanitize all toys between groups of children and provide professional deep cleaning each evening.
- ♦ Maintain Reme Halo units on all AC Units and run them!
- Keep the classes as one and not mix groups of children as often as possible.
- ♦ Though HIPPA limits how much we can reveal, we will always be as transparent as possible about any known cases within Sherwood.
- We are a licensed childcare facility in the state of Texas and will do everything in our power to remain open and provide a safe place for the children.

In the event that Sherwood has to close...

- For up to two weeks (10 days total), there will be no refund or credit of tuition.
- For beyond two weeks and up to four weeks, up to 10 days worth of tuition will be credited to each account.
- Beyond four weeks, tuition will be charged at a 25% rate to maintain staff and remote learning.
- Each child will also receive sick tuition credits that may be applied to accounts.

All students will be provided with activity packs, online learning and/or a combination of both depending on age group for any closure beyond 72 hours.
